Thanks for thinking this through so well. I agree, clarifying the disability focus for IH is essential by all means. And the more general references of Hemp Helping Humanity is also good but not as central as the main focus of IH, therefore, Hemp for Disabilities or Hemp supporting Disabilities makes more sense to me.

My sense is "hemp solutions for disabilities" is both a general and specific way to clarify that Inclusive Hemp is providing assistive solutions for people with disabilities. Would you think "hemp solutions for disabilities" would be your lead choice in that regard?

Or: Hemp for Disabilities Solutions better?

Or: Hemp Supporting Disability Solutions?

I like Hemp Solutions for Disabilities, since "solutions" is a positive reference and infers a coordinated efforts to problem solve functionally, whereas "supporting" may infer personal care which IH is not offering, a tough the word supporting can also work, then Hemp Supporting Disabilities would be a punchy tag line.
